



PCP and EUPOL COPPS conclude pilot Human Rights Training Programme

The Palestinian Civil Police (PCP) and EUPOL COPPS concluded a six-day pilot Human Rights Training Program for 23 police officers in Jericho, focusing on application of human rights provisions for operational police officers, and going through practical exercises and different scenarios.



EUPOL COPPS provides Economic Crime training for PCP

EUPOL COPPS' experts delivered a second specialised training course in economic crime to the PCP's Economic Crimes Unit, with the aim of achieving concrete synergies between investigators and prosecutors. The training was designed at the request of the PCP's Economic Crimes Unit.



Palestinian Traffic Police performs defensive tactics in Salfit

The Traffic Police performed a variety of exercises in the West Bank town of Salfit in a new bid to raise the capabilities of the PCP in dealing with traffic related matters, in co-ordination with EUPOL COPPS. Fourteen police officers from across the West Bank participated in the drills dealing with traffic violators and arresting lawbreakers.

EUPOL COPPS' Police Advisory section delivered barcode scanners, printers and labels for the PCP, to be used in all districts across the West Bank. According to the Chief of Police's Assistant for Logistic Affairs, Brig. Gen. Rashid HAMDAN, the PCP will soon switch from manual to barcoding of items in PCP's warehouses. He said the 8,000 Euros project would save time and effort once all items are digitalized.



EUPOL COPPS and Palestinian Justice Institutions conclude anti-corruption programme

EUPOL COPPS and the Palestinian justice institutions concluded a comprehensive anti-corruption and money laundering training programme to enhance the skills of judges and prosecutors. During the programme five modules were provided, covering subjects including techniques to investigate corruption, recovery of assets, forgery, fraud and mutual assistance at the international level.
