Royal College of Defence Studies visit to EUPOL COPPS

EUPOL COPPS hosted a high level delegation from the Royal College of Defence Studies, UK. Twenty three delegates from 12 countries received a mission briefing from the support and operational sections of the mission. During the presentations EUPOL COPPS outlined our strategic approach to institutional reform and capacity building in the occupied Palestinian territories with particular focus on the Palestinian Civil Police and the judiciary.



Roundtable on fair trial

EUPOL COPPS facilitated a Roundtable Event on Fair Trial for District practitioners in the criminal justice sectors. This final event concluded a series of roundtable events held in April and May in Jenin, Jericho, and Bethlehem, as well as some 15 focal group meetings with District Judges, Prosecutors, Police Commanders and Lawyers. These events are seen as an important step in the wider approach towards the full realization of the right to a fair trial in Palestine.



EUPOL COPPS facilitates a workshop on Asset Recovery

EUPOL COPPS facilitated a workshop on Asset Recovery. The focus of this workshop was on the international recovery of the proceeds of crime. Beneficiaries of the workshop were specialized judges of the Corruption Crimes Court, prosecutors of the Palestinian Anti-Corruption Commission, members of the Ministry of Justice and the Palestinian Financial Follow-up Unit.
