EUPOL COPPS supports a visit to the Netherlands for members of Palestinian Anti Corruption Commission

EUPOL COPPS facilitated a visit to the Netherlands as part of its cooperation and support to the Palestinian Anti Corruption Commission (PACC) to expose participants to how the Netherlands system of witness protection functions from both a legal and practical aspect, along with to help the PACC with its ongoing activities in developing a legal framework for witness protection on corruption cases. The delegation visited the witness protection team located in the national public prosecution office in Rotterdam. Legal and practical aspects of witness protection were discussed, along with case studies presented.



Bingham Centre for the Rule of Law facilitates roundtable discussion with Palestinian Justice Sector institutions

EUPOL COPPS and the Bingham Centre for the Rule of Law facilitated a roundtable discussion funded by the UK Arab Partnership Fund for all key justice officials -- Chief justice, Minister of Justice, Attorney General, along with the Legal Advisor to the President. The aim of the workshop was to further discuss and agree upon positions already taken in London on better defining the roles and mandates of the key justice institutions.

EUPOL COPPS organised and funded a study trip for six Palestinian prosecutors to Rabat, Morocco. The purpose of the study trip is for the prosecutors to study amongst other things, litigation techniques and skills, at the Moroccan Judicial Training Institute in Rabat. The introductory lecture was held by the head of the training department, Judge Ahmedo Akri.
