Police Code of Ethics discussed in Slovenia

Palestinian Civil Police (PCP) officers concluded a study trip to Slovenia focusing on drawing up and implementing a "Code of Ethics" as a vehicle to foster relations between the police and the civil society. The visit took place within the framework of the EUPOL COPPS/PCP/UNDP joint Accountability Programme, in the presence of the Palestinian Independent Commission for Human Rights (ICHR). Part of the visit concentrated on examining the experience of the Slovenian police in developing their force according to their code of conduct.



EUPOL COPPS hosted the Folke Bernadote Academy

The Head of Mission Kenneth Deane received a delegation from the famous Folke Bernadote Academy (FBA), headed by General Director Sven-Eric Söder who had the opportunity to meet the Swedish contingent of EUPOL COPPS. In a parallel visit, two Swedish experts from the FBA visited the Mission as part of an assessment of the implementation of UNSC Resolution 1325 on Women, Peace and Security. The experts got a chance to gather a lot of insights on EUPOL COPPS activities related to gender and women empowerment.



UK Scoping Visit on the Justice Sector

EUPOL COPPS facilitated a scoping visit, funded by the UK Consulate General in Jerusalem, on the justice sector and the judiciary for representatives of the Slynn Foundation headed by Sir Henry Brooke and Sir David Latham, and for the Director of the Bingham Centre for the Rule of Law, Professor Sir Jeffrey Jowell. The delegation met with EUPOL COPPS Head of Mission Kenneth Deane as well as with high profile Palestinian representatives from the Justice sector, thus paving the way for future cooperation.



Closer cooperation between Palestinian and Italian lawyers

The Head of the Palestinian Bar Association (PBA), Mr. Hussein Shabaneh, and Mr. Sergio Paparo, President of the Florence Bar Association, signed a cooperation agreement in Italy to support the exchange of professional experience and for support of PBA activities. The representatives of the Italian National Bars Council also discussed ways to support the PBA and a cooperation agreement was signed by the parties.
